Instructional Continuity Special Education

- Special education collaboration on cohesive case loads and scheduling
- Integral role in hiring of new teachers and ongoing mentoring and coaching sessions with new teachers
- Discontinued use of Fastbridge (*lack of progress monitoring tools*)
- Special Education meetings (*1st quarter*)
- Purchased student licenses from Front Row Education
- Upcoming professional development (*March, 2018*)

RTI/MTSS Math

- MYP MTSS block 4 days a week
- Walk to Math block - ELII
- Math RTI/MTSS coordinator went from part-time status to full-time status
- 35 students receiving Tier 2 interventions
- 18 students receiving Tier 3 interventions (5 days a week)
- Creation of MTSS team to review data prior to moving into tiers or possible referrals for special education services

Social & Emotional Learning

- Guidance Counselor, Ana Solis, meets with 20 students weekly. She conducts 10 individual student check-ins in grades EL1 - 8th grade.
- Creation of the Climate & Culture Team
- Ongoing professional training by the Network Support Office and the Office of Social & Emotional support
- Created and submitted action plan focused on staff to staff relationships and social emotional learning

Arts

- EC: focuses on being in control of self and part of an ensemble.
- EL1: connects their chosen country of study for international week
- EL2: focuses on community (local and school); studies music from their chosen country and expands their performance to include languages spoken by our students and families.
- 6th grade: focus on building skills in the Arts.
- 7th/8th: focuses on connecting topics studied in Individuals and Societies.
