
# General Observations & Next Steps

- Reading & Math attainment remains high
- Growth data for MOY 2018 weaker than MOY 2017
- Growth projections vary for each student. Some students have made their growth projections at MOY, others are on track to make their growth projections, and some have shown no growth.
- Math 2-5 test versus Math 6+
- High growth and attainment in 7th grade
- Low growth in reading and math in 8th grade
- Students in 39% or below, are making stronger gains than students in 50% or above.

- Continue data review using data protocols
- Restructuring MTSS using NWEA instructional reports or Map to Khan
- Academic Support & Enrichment
- Differentiation: using the data to inform instruction
