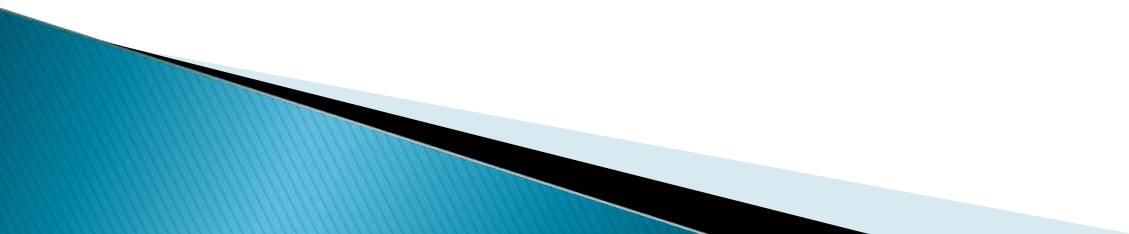

What do you want students to be able to do and then how will you get them there?

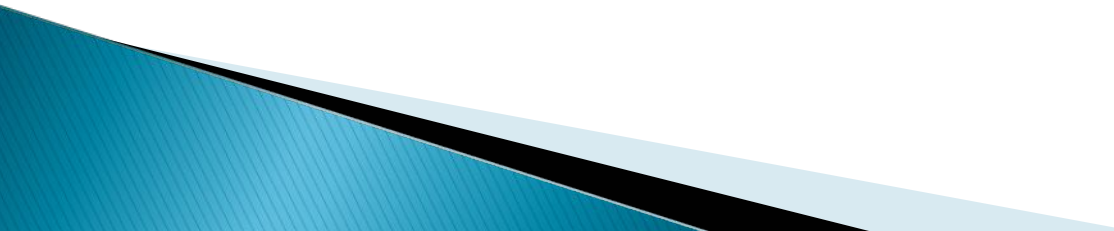

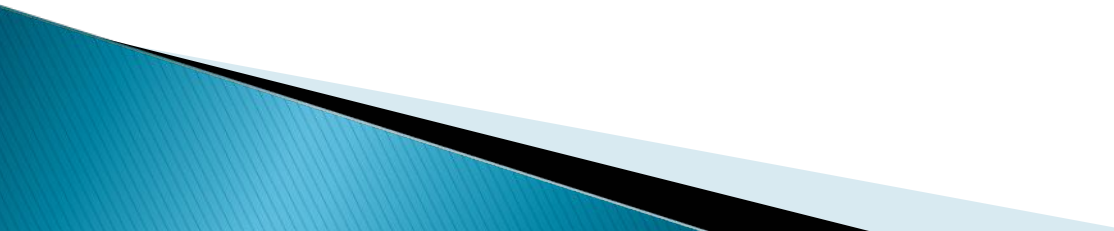
## **Student Reflection**
